As we look toward our upcoming meeting on **Sunday January 4th**, I am excited about the opportunity for us to dream and discern together. We are at an important moment in our life as a congregation, and your voice is vital to understanding where God is leading us next. To help us have a deep and meaningful conversation, I’m sharing several questions that will guide our time together. I invite you to pray over these topics and reflect on your own experiences within our church home:

1. Our Identity & Calling

- **Who is God calling us to become?** Looking beyond what we do, who are we being shaped to be as a people of faith?
- **How are we reaching out?** In what ways is God calling us to address the new challenges and opportunities emerging in our local community and within our own walls?

2. Our Life Together

- **Our Life of Faith:** How would you describe the spiritual heartbeat of our congregation?
- **Our Strengths:** What are the positive qualities or unique strengths that make our church special?

3. Our Gatherings & Growth

- **Our Worship:** When we gather to praise God, what is that experience like? How would you describe the “soul” of our worship services?
- **Our Vision for Formation:** What is our hope for our educational programs? How do we see ourselves growing in faith across all generations?

How to prepare: There is no need to write out formal answers! Simply come ready to share your heart, your stories, and your observations. We want to hear where you see God moving and where you see opportunities for us to grow.

I am so grateful for this community and for the ways you live out your faith every day. I look forward to our time of shared reflection.
